- Initial Registration of dogs may be granted to dogs that are lacking adequate registration or have registration papers from any organization not approved by Dogo Canario Club of America.
- Registration shall be considered to any dog who in the opinion of a breed inspector or other licensed judge meeting the approval of DCCA, is of merit to be admitted to the studbooks with no less than a rating of "Very Good". The dog shall be admitted without pedigree and this shall be noted on the on the registrations and pedigrees until such time three (3) generations of descendants have been registered. The required certification of the individual dog (SEC.G.) must be completed and signed. Certifications are subject to DCCA approval with the right to correct or cancel.
- *** If the certification takes place at a DCCA event, a copy of the certification will be on file and SEC. G. need not be signed, but the location and date must be completed.**
- For dogs previously registered with a national kennel club that is a member of the Federation Cynologique Internationale, please complete the Individual Registration Application.

The following instructions will guide you in completing your application.

1. Please use blue or black ink only. To ensure proper registration of this litter, print capital letters and stay within the boxes. Skip a box where a space would normally appear.
2. SIGNATURES: whenever an owner's signature is required and dog is co-owned, both signatures are necessary. Signature of persons other than owners or lessees will be accepted only if power of attorney or other official authorization has been filed with DCCA.
